# Camp Hart

Musser Scout Reservation February 3 - 5, 2012

The Washington District's 2012 Klondike Derby will be held at Camp Hart on the weekend of February 3 - 5, 2012 and hosted by the Washington Chapter of the Order of the Arrow. Headquarters for the weekend will be at Perry Long Lodge. All troop registration and staff meetings will take place there.

To enter the Klondike Adventure please register by January 20, late registration incurs a \$2/pp Late Fee. A \$8.00/pp fee is required. Make checks payable to: "Cradle of Liberty Council, BSA". Send to: Bob Gabage, 401 Runnymede Ave. Jenkintown, PA 19046. (All participants will receive a patch.) Troop and patrol rosters & Grandview Release must be completed at time of check-in.

Each troop camping for the weekend will be responsible for reserving a cabin and/or campsite with the Council Office. Camp Hart is set aside for the Washington District Klondike Derby.

Each unit is expected to cook it's own meals. Campsite Inspection will include posting of Patrol, Duty Roster & Menu. Hot coffee (Adults) and hot chocolate (Scouts) will be available throughout the day Saturday at Perry Long Lodge. (Please have everyone bring their own cup or mug).

The events are designed to test our scouts on teamwork, scout spirit and scouting skills. Sleds will follow the Camp Trails encountering challenging events and obstacles using various scouting skills. Leaders, start training your scouts for winter camping.

Upon arrival at Camp Hart, proceed directly to Perry Long Lodge for check-in. Senior Patrol Leaders must attend the Troop Leader meeting Friday evening to receive their Klondike event patrol packets. Each patrol will have a Patrol ID number assigned to them. This ID # must be written on each score sheet before beginning the event. The Race will start Saturday after flag raising and opening ceremonies and end with an awards campfire.

Boy Scout Patrols who build at the Derby & use a "Primitive" sled as Boy Scouts did back during the earliest Klondike Derbies will earn 10 Extra Points for their Patrol. Sled construction MUST USE ONLY unvarnished/non-pressure treated wood (dowels &/or natural sticks – NO Bamboo) & Twine (Sisal), see Building Materials List & Sketch for recommended suggestions. At the end of the race the Sled MUST BE TURNED-IN to Race Officials for use in the Campfire for an additional 10 Extra points. Don't be afraid to use your imagination for your own sled design. As Always NO Wheels, if your sled has them you will be asked to remove them before you start the race. Troops continue to receive EXTRA Points for OA Meeting attendance, Planning Weekend Attendance & Station Staffing. Venturing Crew sleds must have a minimum of 2 Girls to compete.

- 1. Have fun.
- 2. Be Safe.
- 3.  $N_0$  throwing snowballs.
- 4. NO SNEAKERS. Dress appropriately for the weather.
- 5. NO Portable heaters or electric blankets permitted.
- 6. See a member of the committee with any questions or concerns.
- 7. **No** Nails, Screws, Pressure-treated Wood, Varnish, Paint, Rope (exception-Towrope), &/or Bamboo maybe used to construct Troop Sleds.





#### PRIMITIVE SLED MATERIALS LIST

(Sled uses natural sticks w/Pine runners & optional attachment points diagramed above.)

TWINE (Sisal type ONLY) for tying Lashings

A (Runners): 2pcs – 4" x ½" x 6.5' Pine (+ Optional attachment points see listing above)

B & B1 (Cross-Supports): 5pcs – approx 1" Dia x 18" Sticks

C (Flooring): 4-8pcs – approx 1" Dia X 5' Sticks

D (Rear Uprights): 2pcs – approx 1" Dia x 40" sticks

E (2<sup>nd</sup> Rear Uprights): 2pcs – approx 1" Dia x 31 sticks

F (2<sup>nd</sup> Front Uprights): 2pcs – approx 1" Dia x 22" sticks

G (Front Uprights): 2pcs – approx 1" Dia x 13" sticks

H (Handrails): 2pcs – approx 1" Dia x 6' Sticks

I (Towbar): 1pc – approx 2" Dia x 16" stick

J (Handlebar): 1pc – approx 1-2" Dia x 20" stick

Rope for towrope (with 7 pulling loops pre-tied)
