

Merit Badge College Reminders that Will Help You Succeed

(or how to avoid getting partials)

You **must** bring Blue Cards to the first session that have already been filled out and signed by one of your unit leaders. Bring an extra Blue card if you are taking Graphic Arts.

Bring a bag lunch to be eaten in the cafeteria in either the third or fourth period.

Bring the [Course Schedule](#) which lists the times, and which building and room your Merit Badge courses are in.

Bring your own schedule of the classes you selected and in which period.

You may not take five Merit badges, four is the maximum permitted.

We are using classrooms in five different buildings. They are identified in the first column of the schedule and there is a [map](#) in the registration material. There will be signage and guides on our two Saturdays.

Report to the Chapel for the Opening Ceremony if you are taking a first period class.

You **must** read the Merit Badge Pamphlet in advance of the classes and bring it to the two sessions. If the badge is completed on the first Saturday, the second session for that badge will not be necessary.

You **must** have reviewed and completed any Pre Requirements prior to the first class. There is a [Pre Requirement List](#) in the registration information.

You **must** print a copy of the Merit Badge Workbook and use this for any Pre Requirements. You must bring the Workbook to each of your two classes.

Parents, this is a drop and go event as space is limited. The class rooms hold 20 scouts; there is no room for observers. Enjoy the nearby Mall or come back when your scout's last class is over.

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Bring the Course Schedule which lists which building and room your Merit Badge courses are in.

You must have reviewed and completed any Pre Requirements prior to the first class. There is a Pre Requirement List in the registration information. If there is nothing next to your badge, please check back, as it will be updated on a weekly basis until it is complete.
